Introduction

The contracting authority is the Southeast European Law Enforcement Center (SELEC), a law enforcement international organisation located in Bucharest/Romania, 13 September Avenue No. 1-5, Palace of Parliament, 10th Floor, Phone: +40.21.303 6009, Fax: +40.21.303 6077, www.selec.org.

The Southeast European Law Enforcement Center, as Beneficiary, is launching a three-offers method procedure, in accordance with its Financial Rules and Regulations, in order to contract 3 notebooks.

This procedure is part of the implementation of ***Project SIRAS – Strengthening the fight against firearms trafficking in Southeastern Europe***, co-funded by the Internal Security Fund of the European Union.

Both HDDs (replacing and replaced HDDs) will remain the property of the Beneficiary.</p>
Note:	<p>External adaptors for the equipment's interface and ports will not be accepted.</p> <p>The products presented in the offer will be accompanied by all the necessary accessories for them to function (hardware and software module) at the parameters demanded in the present technical specification, even if the beneficiary has omitted to request them explicitly.</p> <p>It is requested to attach documents issued by the manufacturer containing the technical specifications for the products presented in the offer.</p> <p>The delivered equipment will be new. Remanufactured equipment and/or equipment containing elements which were previously used will not be accepted.</p>

2. Evaluation criteria: technical compatibility and best price.
3. Any interested provider must submit an offer that should specify:
 - the product offered and the delivery date;
 - the price in EUR (specifying whether it is VAT inclusive or not);
 - the technical features;
 - a recent confirmation of the company details (*certificat constatator*) issued by the Trade Register

- a statement mentioning that international warranty will be offered (including the countries specified in the technical requirements) and also mentioning the company that insures repairs or other intervention in case of malfunction within the warranty period in the respective countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Moldova).
4. The value of the contract will be up to EUR 6,000 (plus VAT for Romanian providers).
 5. Offers must be submitted to SELEC by e-mail, in English, **by 2 September 2019 09.00 hrs. Bucharest time**, at the e-mail address: msotirescu@selec.org.
 6. Our system will not accept e-mails that have more than 10 MB. If required, segregate your e-mails to accommodate e-mail data restrictions. For segregated e-mails please use sequence of emails like E-mail 1, E-mail 2, etc. in the subject line.
 7. For attachment purposes please only use MS Word, Excel, Power Point, jpeg and PDF formats.
 8. Incomplete offers, offers received after the deadline and offers in other language than English will not be taken into consideration.
 9. All bidders will be announced in due time about the outcome of the selection.
 10. All the information collected in relation to this procurement will only be used for this purpose and will be treated as confidential.
 11. No costs in relation to this procedure shall be incurred to SELEC.
